Usually universal fitting kits from KMart are a nightmare which will not fit anything, however, this was not the case with the A.P. 50.

In fact the fitting kit is so good you would think Leyland designed it. The unit can be fitted to a P76 with no changes to the car except two holes which will have to be drilled into the floor to mount the speedsensor.

I fitted my unit to a V8 Auto and it works perfectly, time will tell how long it lasts. Parts are available from the dealer in Sydney.
