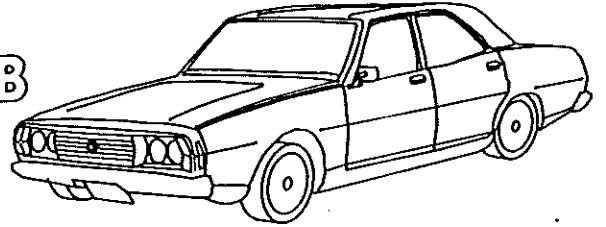
## **GENERAL INFORMATION:**

- BUSHWALKING -** Marked tracks are provided on the property or enjoy a walk through the Pretty Gully Rainforest Reserve. (15 acres).
- BIRDWATCHING -** Birds and Marsupial life are plentiful. For example - Glossy Black Cockatoo, Wompoo pigeon, Brushtail Rock Wallaby & Red Leg Pademelon.
- GOLD PANNING -** Evidence of the old gold seekers, who worked the Pretty Gully gold field from about 1859, can be seen along Pretty Gully creek and the gullies running into it. A few specs of gold may still be won. Gold Pans can be hired for \$2.00 each.
- LANIKAI HOMESTEAD -**
- GARDENING** - If you are interested in gardening you are welcome to visit Jim and Lyn Wright's home and enjoy a stroll around their gardens.
- ANIMALS** - Also you are welcome to view the variety of poultry and pheasants, including Cape Barren Geese, Chestnut Teals & Water Whistlers, at the Lanikai Homestead.
- TEA & COFFEE** - Whilst you take a stroll around the Homestead, you are welcome to enjoy a cup of tea or coffee, and some biscuits, for a fee of \$3.00.

- ## **CAMPSITES:**
- TALLOW WOOD CAMPSITE** - Main camping ground with creek water available from a tank. Two wheel & four wheel drive access during dry and wet weather. Bush toilets. Fire wood supplied.
- CREEK POOL CAMPSITE -** Located beside Pretty Gully Creek. Two wheel & four wheel drive access during dry weather, four wheel drive access during wet weather. Bush toilets. Fire wood supplied.
- DIVIDING CREEK CAMPSITE -** Located beside the Clarence River. Four wheel drive access only in dry weather (steep, rough track). No facilities available as yet. Track cannot be used if wet, therefore vehicles on site need to vacate prior to rain or remain on site until track is dry and safe enough to be used, to leave.
