Well that's all from me for the moment. I hope to see a good turn out at the November meeting.

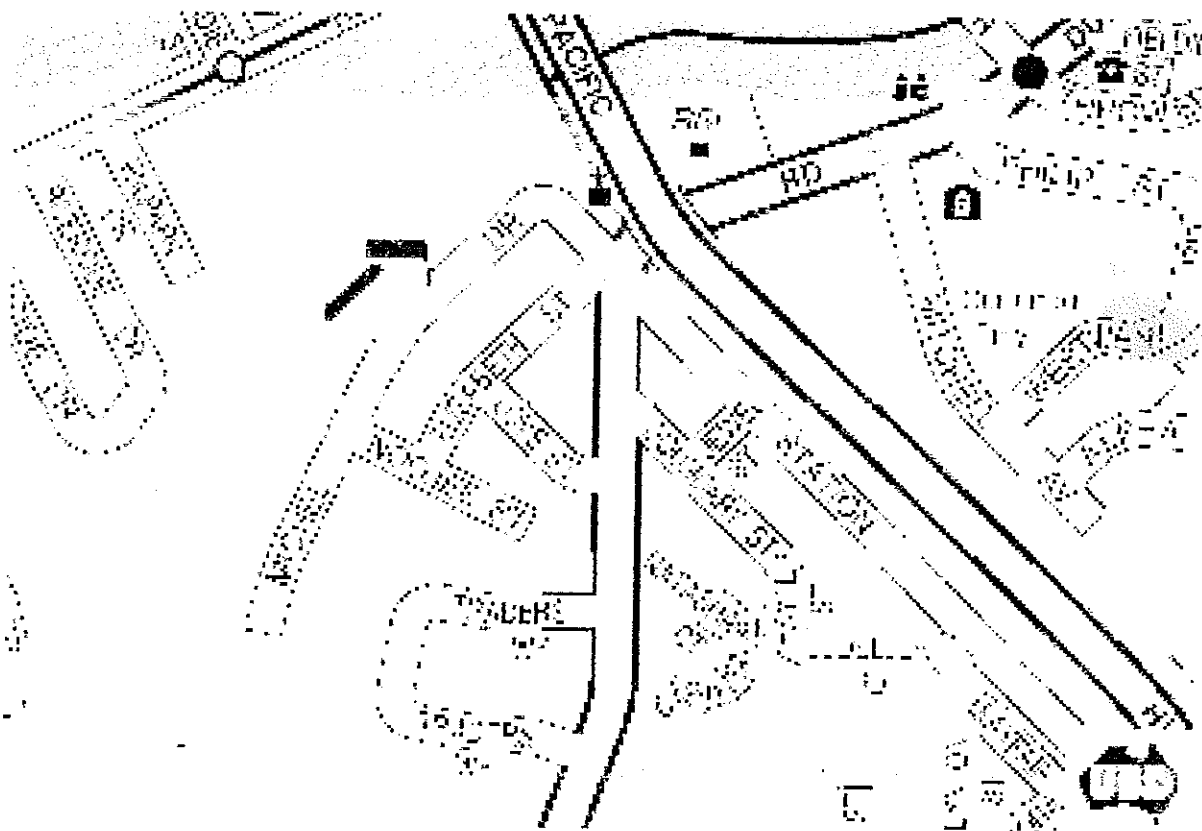

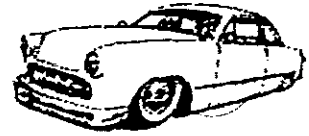
